Group size Large events

Materials

10 cups with labeled using the periodic table of elements for Nitrogen Phosphorus and Potassium

if you use disposable cups put some water in each cup.

2 Nitrogen cups

3 Phosphorus cups

5 Potassium cups

8 ping pong balls

Table

Prizes Sour Patch kids first Prize Nitrogen, Sour Punch straws second prize Phosphorus and variety pack small candy third prize Potassium.

Directions

Set the cups in a triangle formation at one end of the table.

The participant stands at the other end of the table.

The participant gets four tries to toss or bounce the ping pong ball into the cup.

When a ping pong ball lands in a cup the game is over.

Notes: Enthusiasm really makes this game fun Talk about the roles of NPK as the participant is tossing the ball.
