Career Scavenger Hunt Activity

Description:

This activity can be used as a hook or interest approach to the lesson, a career show activity, or an end of presentation activity! It is made up of materials that are commonly found in a backpack, wallet, or purse. Students will be grouped up so they can pool their items. The first team with all of the items wins the scavenger hunt. Award this team with a prize, maybe a piece of company paraphernalia, gifts, or candy if you are in a pinch.

Each item represents one aspect of their search for a career. The scavenger hunt can be plugged with the explanations for a career show or blank with an accompanied PowerPoint that students can fill in after the scavenger hunt. If you are short on time you may have students volunteer to read the descriptions out loud. Do not cold call students to read! Volunteers only. Or you may discuss what each item represents. This interactive activity can be used at a trade show or career show and can be accessed with a QR code.

Materials and Their Descriptions:

- *ID Card:* Know who you are, what gets you up in the morning, what you want out of a career!
- **Pen, black or blue ink:** Always be armed with a pen, you never know when you will need to write something important down or sign something!
- Notebook paper: And of course have something to write on!
- Wrist Watch: Being on time is important! You don't want to be late for a meeting with your future employer!
